Checklist: What to Bring to Your Passport Appointment

 Completed passport application, form DS-11 or DS-82 	Forms must be typed or completed in black ink. Do not sign the DS-11 form. Form DS-82 for renewal applications (restrictions apply). Check Travel.state.gov for more information.
Passport photo	One 2" x 2" color photo taken within the last six months. Front view with a white or off-white background.
o Evidence of U.S. citizenship	An original of one of the following documents: U.S. Birth Certificate (must include full names of both parents) Certificate of Naturalization or Citizenship U.S. Passport Consular Report of Birth Abroad You must also submit a photocopy of both sides of the citizenship evidence.
o Identification	Current, government issued identification containing your signature and photograph or physical description is required. Examples: Valid Driver's License or Identification Card, U.S. Passport, Official Military Identification card, Certificate of Naturalization or of Citizenship You must also submit a photocopy of both sides of the identification.
o Additional documents	Applicants who have changed their name may need to provide an original Marriage Certificate or Court Order. Supporting documents may be required in cases of adoption, sole custody of a minor, guardianship of a minor, and other cases.
o Payment	Check or money order preferred; credit cards will be accepted. Cash will <u>not</u> be accepted. \$60 expedite service fee and \$19.53 1–2-day delivery fees are optional .
o Children under 16 years old	Both parents or legal guardian(s) and the child must appear in person. Please see www.Travel.State.gov for allowable exceptions. Both parents must present valid identification with photocopies.
